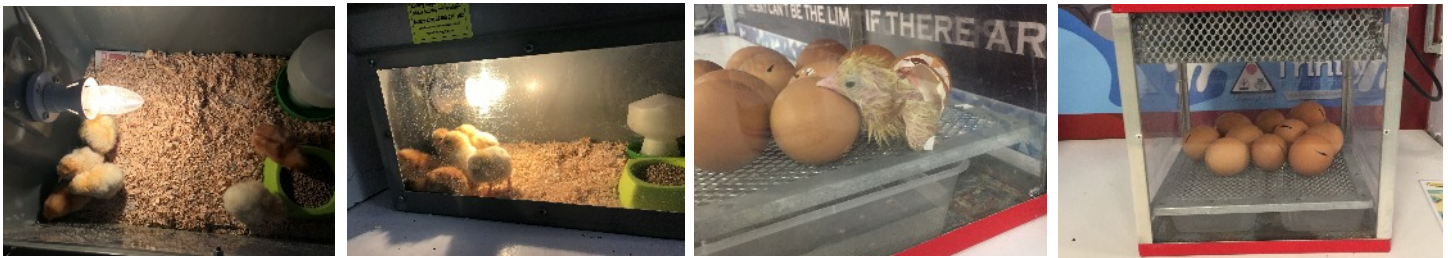

## Dangerous parking

### how you can make a difference:
