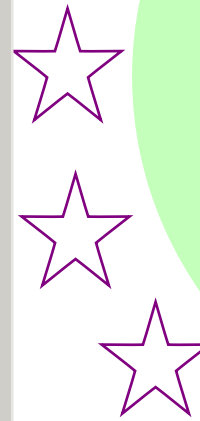
The HAF Programme supports children and families in the school holidays.
