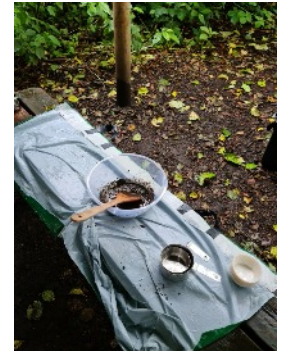

## Forest Schools...

This is so exciting! Forest schools begins next week for all children; Seedlings to Year 6!

Forest Schools was created in Scandinavia in the 1950's and started to be used in the UK in the 1990's. It is a totally different way of learning than being in the classroom and allows children be extremely creative and guide their own development. The children will be outside in the wildlife area and may learn things like tying a variety of knots, tool use, fire lighting and building dens or shelters.

Please refer to the letter that was sent home via the Weduc app on Thursday for further details. Please ensure that your child brings the relevant clothing and footwear for their session. As you know, the weather isn't going to be particularly good over the coming months. Under normal circumstances, when it is raining, we wouldn't be outside. However, Forest Schools is about building resilience and allowing the children to do things they wouldn't normally do so whether it is rain or shine we will still be outside doing lots of wonderful activities. Snacks and drinks will be provided to keep them warm and happy but the children are likely to get wet and dirty so please can they bring appropriate clothing. Wellies, walking boots or a very old pair of trainers would be ideal and waterproof or very old clothes are also going to be essential. The items also need to be long sleeved/legged to avoid cuts and grazes and protect the children as much as possible as well as keeping them warm. After the session, the children will change into their school uniform.
