Friday 24th September - Macmillan Coffee Morning on the Junior Playground

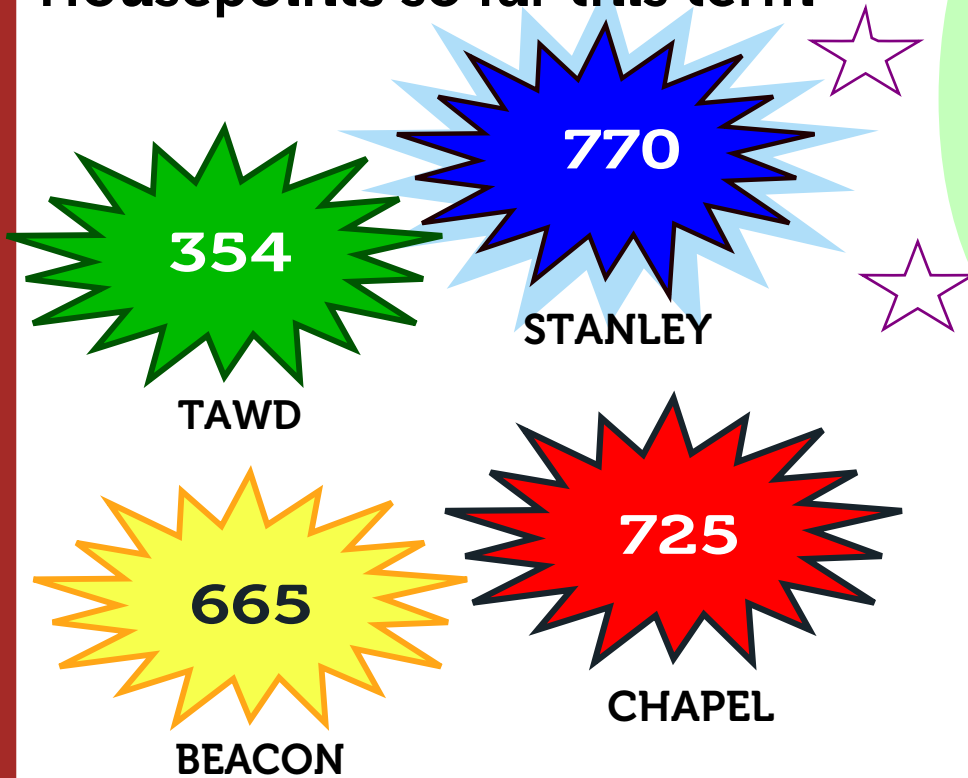
Saturday 25th September @ 9 am – Old Skem Tidy Up 2 (with a brew and a bacon butty)
