LUNCH ORDERING

From 1st September we are asking you to please take time with your child to place their lunch order via Weduc - you may place the order 3 weeks in advance or daily if you wish.

Instructions: Go to PAYMENTS, select your child's name, click on the 3 lines (top right) and select Catering purse/Meal order – please add funds, then proceed to make your menu choices for the days/weeks ahead. If you require any help, please do not hesitate to contact Mrs Mitchell in the school office.

School lunches will cost £2.35 from 1st September. If you have arrears from July, please note that the arrears must be cleared before you are able to purchase a meal from September.

Lunches for a full week will cost £11.75 - please ensure that you have sufficient funds in your catering purse so that you can make a purchase.
